OWR Working Conditions

OWR Worker

As an Outside Work Release (OWR) participant you are allowed to fulfill the requirements of your court ordered sentence by performing some type of labor and/or any other job as prescribed by the Sheriff. As a condition of being a participant you are detailed to work at a variety of worksites, with a person from that worksite detailed as a supervisor. Supervisors at the worksite are responsible for ensuring you fulfill the scope of the work detailed and that you follow all the rules of the OWR program as detailed to you by the Work Release Coordinator.

If any supervisor asks you, or attempts to use threats or coercion to get you to perform a function outside the scope of the work detail, or any detail or function that is personal in nature, or to engage in any activity that makes you feel uncomfortable, you should refuse the request and immediately contact the Work Release Coordinator at (530)822-7373 and report the activity.
