### **Sutter County Sheriffs Work Release Program (O.W.R.)**

**(530) 822-7373 or (530) 822-7302**

This program allows individuals to serve sentences by working on City, County, or State property instead of serving time in jail. Each eight (8) hour work day counts as one day served in jail.

### **Qualifications**

1. Your total sentence cannot exceed Sixty (90) days. Excluding Good time Work time
2. You must: be physically able to perform manual labor or assigned Tasks.
3. You must: not have been convicted of a violent crime, pass a classification screening, not be a registered offender as described under sections 11590 H&S, 290 PC, and 186.30 PC, or 186.22 PC, or affiliates/participates with any known gang members or have prior failures to report or failure to complete O.W.R.
4. You must be able to work a minimum of 2 days per week if you are employed and working 40 hrs per week, you must show proof of employment. **Payroll Check**  
(A regular work week for work release is 4 days per week.)
5. You must pay a \$50.00 Admin fee, \$13.00 per day with a minimum of ten (10) days and every ten (10) days of work thereafter. If time to serve is ten 10 days or less, all fees must be paid in advance. **These fees are non refundable.**
6. You must not have any pending criminal or civil cases within the state of California.
7. If you are denied due to one or more of the above **Qualifications**, you may appeal your denial to the **Sutter County Jail Administrator**; when you report to custody.

**HOW TO APPLY:** If you are interested in the above program, please bring your court commitment papers to the Work Release office, (**No less than 10 days prior to your report date**). If you do not qualify or decide not to participate in the program, you must report to the Sutter County jail on the date and time as directed by the courts.

**DIRECTIONS: From the Sutter County Courthouse, Go south on 2nd street turning left just before the road curves to the right (Garden Hwy) following the levee road south past the Sutter County Animal Control Office to the end of the road. Arrive at 44 2<sup>nd</sup> Street (Whiteaker Hall/Sheriff Training Center.)**
